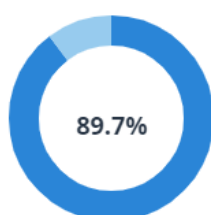

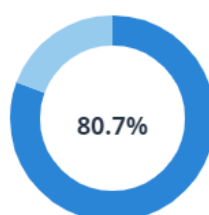
## STUDENT OUTCOMES FOR CERTIFICATE III IN FINANCIAL SERVICES
