Year 12

- All Year 12 students are currently in their Trial HSC Assessment block and therefore there are no timetabled lessons this week. An Adjusted Timetable was shared with all students and families yesterday (Monday 16 August).
- Students must attend their timetabled zoom assessment time to be marked present for the assessment.
- There are no Zoom PC classes for Year 12 students during the Trial HSC Assessment block.

Year 11

- All Year 11 students are to follow their school timetable and attend all of their classes at the timetabled time for every lesson. We are currently in week 2 of the school timetable.
- As per the Stay at Home Public Health Order there is **no** workplace learning for any student this week. School-based Apprentices and Trainees need to clarify with their employer whether they are considered an essential worker. It is essential that you notify the College.
- There **are** Zoom PC classes, commencing at 8.50am, for all Year 11 students as per their timetable. Except for tomorrow as it would normally be a workplace learning day. Any student who is not in attendance during their PC class will be marked absent unless the College office is contacted directly.
